Meadows Fencing Issues The homes backing to the West

The homes backing to the West Meadows Drive fence are responsible for the upkeep of the pickets, posts, and

paint of this fence. After recent storms, some of the fences were severely damaged. Many of those damaged fences have already been repaired or replaced. If your home backs this fence, please take a few minutes to inspect the area and make all repairs as needed.

If you need to stain or re-stain your fence, the

stain is BEHR – Plus 10 – Solid Color – House & Fence Stain – Light Lead #542 and should be available at Home Depot. Given tough Colorado weather, the best results can be obtained if the fence is power washed first to remove damaged stain before re-staining. Also, two coats of stain will provide optimum results.

Curbside Large Item Trash Pick-up Guidelines

The Annual Woodbourne large item trash pick-up will be held on Saturday, June 18, 2022, starting at 7:00 a.m. This is your chance to get rid of those large items that won't usually be picked up like old furniture and appliances. Please note that the following items will **not** be taken:

- Any single item that cannot be lifted by two people
- Liquid of any kind
- Any appliance with a Freon unit, such as refrigerators, freezers, or air conditioners
- Car bodies, car batteries, antifreeze, or motor oil
- Tires (Colorado law)
- Propane tanks
- Concrete, concrete pavers
- Soil, sod, grass clippings, shrubs, or tree limbs less than 12 inches in diameter
- Sealed containers or drums, any item listed as a hazardous material, any corrosives, pesticides, herbicides, or paint
- · Radioactive waste or Pharmaceutical waste
- Industrial or agricultural waste
- Florescent lighting
- Household trash
- Computers, computer screens, televisions, or other electronic devices (Colorado law)

This will be a curbside pickup, just like last year. All items should be curbside by 7:00 a.m.

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Exterior Painted Brick

During the annual homeowners meeting, multiple residents inquired about painting the exterior brick of their home. Although there are already four homes in our neighborhood with painted brick, the ACC guidelines do not allow them and the guidelines have never been amended to approve painted brick. The HOA Board has agreed to survey the community to gauge the community's feelings on this issue. We're asking ALL Woodbourne residents to vote in the one question survey below (one vote per household) and be heard on the issue of allowing exterior painted brick. There has never been a more critical time to be involved in decision making in our neighborhood!
